Mr. Sam's Tribute

Colleagues on both sides of the aisle, and in both Houses, rejoiced "Mr. Sam" the durable Texas Democrat, as he set a record for longevity that is liable to endure a spell.

Rayburn, 79, was born in 1872, in the town of Marshall, Texas. He was a member of the House of Representatives for 32 years, from 1913 to 1945. He was Speaker of the House from 1935 to 1945.

Rayburn became speaker in 1940, succeeding the late William Bankhead of Alabama. He has been speaker since except for five two-year stints in which the Republicans held sway in Congress.

For two hours, Rayburn's associates from both parties in the House spoke glowing tributes to his service.

President John F. Kennedy, himself a former member of the House, joined in the tribute by letter. The President wrote that service records may be measurable, but "immeasurable" is your devotion to cause and country.

Rep. John McCormack of Massachusetts characterized Rayburn as "one of the greatest men in American history."

Responding to the eulogies, Rayburn said: "I thank you from the bottom of a grateful heart."

He said he felt it "a great and towering honor to be a member of the House of Representatives," even for one term.

Rayburn is the second Texan to have risen to the powerful post of House Speaker. The first was John Nance Garner of Urdia, later vice president of the U. S.

If Rayburn ever finds time to reflect on his career, he can view in retrospect the transition of his nation into a position of world influence and power, and its involvement in a procession of crisis including two World Wars and the Korean conflict, the Great Depression and, the last 15 years, the most crucial time of all, the cold war era.

Thiokol Safety Program
