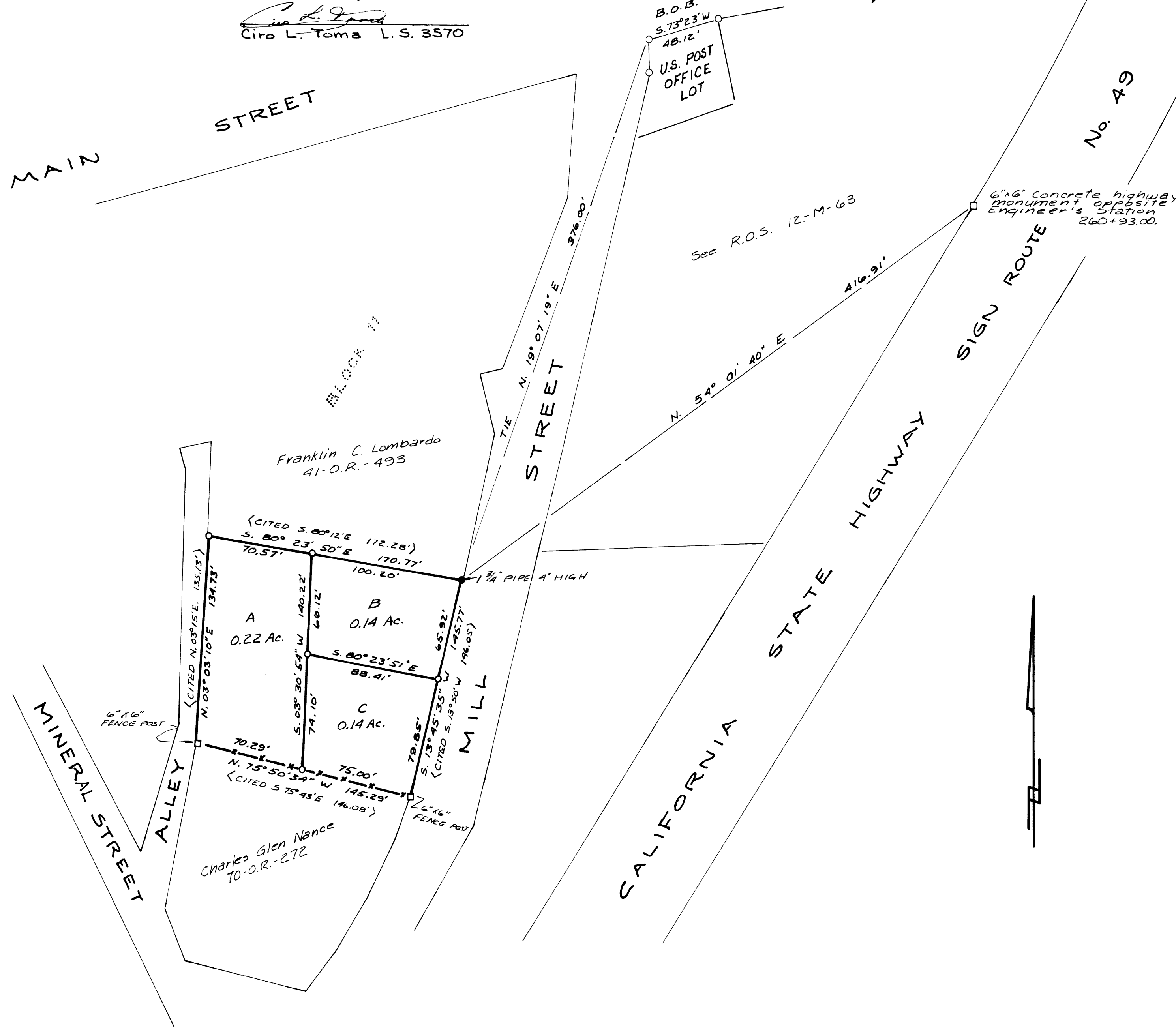
# NOTES & LEGEND

All (cited) data represents information obtained from that certain unofficial map entitled "PLAT of SURVEY of CERTAIN LOTS, CITY of PLYMOUTH" by C.E. Bronson, Licensed Land Surveyor No. 2603, and filed in the office of the Amador County Surveyor.

The meridian of this Survey is based upon the North line of that certain parcel of land delineated and designated "U.S. Post Office Lot" upon that certain official map entitled "Record of Survey, Property of Charles Goodell" and recorded in the office of the Recorder of Amador County in Book 12 of Maps and Plats at page 63; the bearing of which is S. 73° 23' W.

The blue lines shown hereon closely represent the exterior lines of Lot 14, Block 11, as determined from that unofficial map entitled "PLAT of SURVEY of CERTAIN LOTS, CITY of PLYMOUTH" by C.E. Bronson, Licensed Land Surveyor No. 2603 and filed in the office of the Amador County Surveyor. In order to legally establish said blue lines as property lines, it will be necessary for Jack R. Tallman, Franklin C. Lombardo and Charles Glen Nance to enter into boundary line agreements using the bearings and distances shown hereon.
